



COVID-19 NHS TRACK AND TRACE POLICY

With effect from Thursday 24th September, football clubs must now display NHS COVID-19 QR Code Track and Trace Posters for ALL participants or parents to scan as they enter. Everyone MUST be accounted for.

In following this guidance, we will display these as of Wednesday 23rd September in the evening. We will place one on the Covid-19 Station at the entrance to the playing fields and one on our notice board. Each pitch which is in use will also have a Covid-19 Station with a copy of the NHS QR Code, and each team Manager and/or Covid-19 Marshall will also have one.

You will need to download the NHS Track and Trace app via www.covid19.nhs.uk. Madeley White Star FC have no access to data on this app and it is held by the NHS.

We ask you to actively engage in the use of these, as a club we are doing everything we can so that we can continue to play football, and we have a responsibility to keep everybody as safe as possible. The app has a number of tools to protect you, including contact tracing, local alerts and venue check-in. It uses proven technology from Apple and Google, designed to protect every users privacy.

We would also ask that you inform the opposition of the location of these and that they scan these when entering the pitch so the NHS Track and Trace team will be able to do their bit if required. As well as this we ask you continue to follow the use of the Football Activity Consent Forms prior to attending training or a match.

Anyone who does not wish to scan the app, or does not have a compatible smart phone, must complete our manual check in process using the book provided to each team. Failure to provide track and trace information, will result in you being asked to leave our facility.

Any information collected for the purposes of Track and Trace will be stored safely and securely for 21 days by either the team Manager or the team Covid-19 Marshall in accordance with current GDPR guidelines.
